On February 26, 2008, at 10:00 a.m., I reviewed the status of the Level 2. In conversation with various individuals, checking conditions of the roads, it was felt that the Level 2 would remain in place. There will be an update or review of the Level 2 at 4:00 p.m. on this date.

On February 26, 2008, at 4:20 p.m., there was conversation with personnel from the County Garage, and they advised that the roads had improved. We did not get the wind or the additional snow that had been predicted. Therefore at this time things looked good, and it was determined that the Level 2 would be lifted at this time. The second shift coming on will contact me if they feel the conditions need to be reviewed to reinstate the Level 2. Again the back half of the storm did not hit as hard as originally predicted.

Therefore at 4:30 p.m., the Level 2 will be lifted with no snow emergency level in place.
