**Re: Snow Emergency**

Effective Wednesday, February 14, 2007 at 12:00 Noon, the Snow Emergency Level for Ottawa County will be reduced from a Level 3 to Level 2.

A Level 2 Snow Emergency is defined as follows: Roadways are hazardous with blowing and drifting snow. Only those who feel it is necessary to drive should be out on the roadways. Contact your employer to see if you should report to work..

The weather conditions, including wind speed and direction, and the conditions of the county roadways will be evaluated through-out the day to determine if Level 2 will be maintained or if a further reduction in the Snow Emergency Level is warranted.
