On Wednesday, January 28, 2009, a Level 2 had been issued for Ottawa County. An evaluation was made at approximately 5:30 p.m. with conversation with Communications and Mr. Joe Verb from the County Engineer's Office.

After discussion, it was determined that on this date at 7:00 a.m., the Level 2 would be lifted and notification of same by our Communications Division. It appeared that the wind had died down, the sun had actually come out, and the County Engineer's Office at this point had a good handle on the snow removal from County Roads.

At approximately 6:30 p.m., I left the Sheriff's Office en route to my residence in Genoa. This drive takes in much of the County, and I observed the roads and found them to be passable and suitable that the Level 2 could be lifted.

Therefore the Level was terminated by Communications at 7:00 p.m. on this date. There is nothing further to report at this time, and this concludes the documentation of this weather emergency.
